The Public Policy Society is the first student-led platform at our school dedicated to exploring how policies shape communities and global affairs. The Society brings together students to analyze pressing issues, from climate change and technology ethics to international law and social equity.

Hold weekly meetings where members discuss the policies of different countries and engage in comparative analysis, sharpening critical thinking and cross-cultural understanding. Beyond discussions, the Society organizes debates, simulation exercises, and workshops that merge disciplines such as politics, economics, environmental studies, and philosophy.

The inaugural policy contest challenged students to propose solutions for using AI to monitor endangered species in the Andes while protecting indigenous rights and data privacy—an example of our focus on balancing innovation with ethics.

The **flagship event** organized:

Conceptualized and executed Public Policy Club Event on “Building Sustainable Cities – The Role of Architecture in Public Policy” between 3 Universities (Amity University, Symbiosis Law School, IP University) and 4 schools (Genesis, Ardee School, Wembley Academy, Step by Step) at **Amity University** campus in hybrid mode with over 85+ selected Panelists and Participants.

✓ **Head, *History Talks* @ Genesis**

Founded History Talks as a student-led initiative to bring school academics and professors together, giving students broad exposure to diverse historical perspectives beyond the classroom. From ideation to conception, designed the program’s structure, curated speakers, and oversaw the organization of events.

Also moderated discussions and panels, ensuring that complex ideas were accessible while encouraging dialogue and critical thinking.

✓ **President, *Spanish Society* @ Genesis**

Founded the Spanish Society as a student-led initiative to bring students under a student based mentorship network. The society explores Latin American language, history, culture, and languages. It offers a collaborative space for members to engage with Spanish-language activities, while learning about Latin America’s diverse histories, cinema, literature, and sports. Have had multiple workshops on Latin American poetry and novel like Cien Años De Solidad, discussions, Latino food fests, cross-cultural understanding. Our flagship event was based on a comparative analysis of Telenovelas

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in Latin America and Bollywood in India. Students engaged in thought on Telenovelas after watching it and sharing their understanding. It has created appreciation for the richness of Latin American societies, connecting language learning with deeper historical and cultural contexts.

Spanish society has also led to a Spanish language and culture legacy in our school.

### Book Launch & Writing Workshop:

**Conducted Writing Workshop and book launch** at Wembley Academy, Khatauli. Workshop  
marked the official launch of my book 'Pearl and Flame: The Abyssal Crown' with students  
from grades 8–12.

- With an intention to bridge the gap between the power of literacy in metropolitan and rural  
areas, **workshop** began with a fun game of “What If?” and a lively introduction. Guided  
them through the elements of writing, including an activity focused on using the five  
senses to enrich their work. Also shared the inspiration behind Pearl and Flame— Plato’s  
theory of Atlantis—and my journey as an author.
- Goal for the workshop was to provide guidance and encouragement to **future authors**,  
helping them navigate their creative journeys and accomplish in a shorter time what took

me four years. I was thrilled to witness the spark of potential in each student. The session culminated with reading of an excerpt from Pearl and Flame, after which

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each student continued the story in their own voice, adding unique twists and ideas. Their creativity was outstanding, and the top three students were awarded copies of my book.

### Community Service – Project “Udaan”

2024-Ongoing • Designed &

Implemented, **Udaan - Mentorship and Career Incubator** Project for underprivileged girls (Economic weaker section, EWS) in Maa Saraswati Balika Mahavidyalya, a EWS women college in Village Sikandarpur, (District Shamli) U.P.

- Introduced, connected & enrolled 120+ girls to skill development program of Government of India for skilling underprivileged girls.
- Created a Self Help Group (SHG), **Udaan** for about 15 girls in the village for employment and economic self-reliance. Now the SHG enrollment has reached to 48+ girls during the second phase of the SHG operations. Completed logistics of SHG and Secured sponsorship, after successful execution of Phase I, from state government.
- Launched a career cell, connecting 800+ young women in the college to work and gain financial opportunities, which has been a vital step in their financial and social empowerment. Many received jobs within their district and community in multiple domains. Worked on creating awareness by conducting mentorship sessions and imbibing value on environment protection via Tree Plantation drive, training on usage of biodegradable material in order to reduce impact on climate change.
- **“Vidya”, Library for EWS Girls** – From Ideation, **fundraising** in August 2025 at my home golf course in Noida (Noida Golf Course) to launch of Library (“Vidya” means Knowledge in sanskrit) at Maa Saraswati Balika Mahavidyalya, Sikandarpur (District Shamli). The college has been running without any library from over a decade. This initiative is changing life of over 800+ girls giving them access to library during their UG and PG programs, which will help them complete their education and reduce college drop out due to non availability of books & study material.

o Conducted a fundraiser campaign at Noida Golf Course (NGC) in Aug 2025 and **raised 1,05,111/- for building the library 'Vidya'** at Maa Saraswati Balika Mahavidyalaya, a women's college. This college does not have a library since its inception. Completed Library setup by during month of Sep 2025 and launched

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"Vidya" with girls on 3rd October 2025. Elected Student Council for library management, held training and orientation session of student council. Plan to digitalize the library as next step. During this process, a need for mandatory access of digital libraries in rural colleges was identified, which is currently missing in University Grant Commission guidelines for colleges and hence a **need for Policy update**.

### Policy Change Initiative for Digital Libraries -In Progress

- Vidya Library initiative helped identify the gap between rural and metropolitan education systems due to lack of access to digital content and e-books. Reached out to **University Grant Commission (UGC)** and **Ministry of Education**, Govt. of India, requesting policy update by UGC for making digital library setup mandatory in undergraduate and postgraduate colleges.
- Filed Public Interest Litigation (PIL) in Delhi High Court for the same. Presented and heard before the Hon'ble Chief Justice of the Delhi High Court. The Hon'ble Court heard the matter and issued directions to the University Grants Commission (UGC), AICTE, and other statutory bodies such as the NCTE, NMC, PCI, DCI, along with the Higher Education Department of the Government of NCT of Delhi.
- The Hon'ble Bench expressed its expectation that these authorities "shall address the concerns raised in the petition and take appropriate steps to provide for better digital access... and further minimize the digital divide." This marks the important first step toward ensuring that India's education reforms remain inclusive, equitable, and technologically accessible for every learner - regardless of geography.
